A Single bet consists of 1 selection that must win for you to be sure of making a profit.

A selection that is backed each way may be profitable even if it doesn't win, but it must finish within the qualifying positions dictated by the place terms. To return a profit from just the place part of an each way bet, the odds of the placed selection must be above evens after the place fraction has been applied. For example, if the terms are 3 places at 1/5 odds, the total return will exceed the total stake for a selection finishing 2nd or 3rd, only if the win odds are over 5/1.

The Single Bet Calculator allows you to calculate the combined stake, return and profit for up to 20 Singles at a time, with a comprehensive range of options and settings.

Single Bet Calculator Settings Bet Options

The Number of Selections value is automatically updated when you switch between different bet types, if the current value is less than the minimum required for the type of bet. The number of selections can be increased in order to create perms or, in the case of Accumulators, to simply extend the size of the Accumulator. The maximum number of selections that can be specified for any bet is 20, but the value is fixed for any bets that can not be permed, such as Alphabet & Union Jack. Set Selections f is displayed below a selection number to indicate that other options are available for that selection. Simply click the button with the relevant selection number to display a panel containing the less frequently used Rule 4, Dead Heat and Joint Favourite options. The available options will vary depending on a selection's Status, and whether the bet is each way. For example, if a selection has lost, then Win Odds is not relevant, so that option is removed from the form. Win Odds can be entered in either Fraction, Decimal or American format, in accordance with the current odds format that can be changed via the Settings.

Selection 1 - Other Options, & Rule 4 Dead Heat Total - the number of participants finishing in the same position.
